Focus Area: Consult your WMS faculty advisor

Women's Studies Majors also develop a focus area consisting of an integrated cluster of at least 15 credit hours in women's studies (five 3 credit courses). In consultation with their Women's Studies advisor, majors write a rationale that discusses:

1. Educational and personal history that has lead to this degree plan;
2. Personal career and/or educational goals;
3. How the cluster of courses for the focus area contribute to achieving those goals.

This rationale is an important advising tool that provides direction and focus to the student's curriculum.
