*Note 1: Students must enroll in Recital Attendance during each semester of private instruction, and complete the requirement with a "Satisfactory" grade in order to be eligible to continue to enroll in private instruction.

*Note 2: Performance majors must enroll in their concentration's major ensemble during each semester of private instruction or full-time residency (enrollment in 12 or more credit hours), and must obtain a grade of "C-" or better in order to be eligible to continue to enroll in private instruction. Piano/Organ: eight hours of Chamber Ensemble and four hours of choir, band, or orchestra, as assigned by the Director of those areas. Guitar: eight hours of Guitar Ensemble and four hours of Chamber Ensemble.

*Note 3: Students must complete ENG 1010, ENG 1020, SPE 1010, and MTH 1xxx within their first 30 semester hours.

*Note 4: Class Voice I/II, Class Guitar I/II (except for Guitar majors), or Private Instruction I in a secondary area (must pass audition).

*Note 5: Must include the 3-credit hour multicultural requirement and 3-credit global diversity requirement. At least 40 upper-division hours (in courses numbered 3000 or above) are required to graduate.

*Note 6: This course fulfills the Senior Experience requirement.

*Note 7: Electives should be selected in consultation with the student's faculty advisor.

*Note 8: Students whose primary instrument is piano must substitute MUS 261B and 262B, Class Piano III and Class Piano IV.

*Note 9: Students must enroll in Mariachi Ensemble, Gamelan Ensemble, or African Drumming and Dance Ensemble to meet this requirement.
