In addition to the regular expenses of the association for signature events like Alumni Weekends and Homecoming, the primary focus of the board was the completion of the Rowdy the Roadrunner statue, which was installed on campus in January 2024.

The board revised its Finish Line Scholarship fund agreement to allow for more flexibility in offering scholarships to returning students to promote retention, in addition to its original intent of providing degree completion scholarships to students that had previously stopped out. This resulted in 21 scholarships being awarded and a donation to the Barbara Grogan Annual Scholarship.

In 2023, the Alumni Association completed it's fifth season as the official non-profit partner of the Colorado Rockies Foundation facilitating the 50/50 Raffle at all Rockies home games. The association is responsible for maintaining a Bingo-Raffle license with the State of Colorado in addition to recruiting, training, scheduling and managing all volunteers to sell raffle tickets throughout the games and in exchange, the association donates a portion of the raffle profits back to MSU Denver programs, departments and scholarships. The association splits 50% of the jackpot with the Colorado Rockies Foundation.
