- **30-Minute Accessibility Bytes virtual workshops.**

A small cohort of faculty meet throughout the term to work on proactive instructional accessibility. Each faculty member works on an individual project throughout the term. Stipend upon completion of final project.
- **Pilot PDF Remediation Service.**
We are partnering with one department for Fall and hope to expand!

Continuing Services:

- **Access Checks and Course Reviews:** One-off assessment of a course material and a deeper audit across an entire course. We discuss possible next steps; however, remediation is instructor's responsibility.
