





Guaranteed Admissions Requirements

- Students who have a cumulative, unweighted GPA of 2.0 or higher.
- Students age 20 and over with a high school diploma or GED of 145 or higher on all four sections.
- Have at least 24 transferable college credits.

Reviewed Admission

All other applicants will be reviewed for admission with an official high school transcript, a personal statement and an optional letter of recommendation.

Tuition Lock

- Guarantees your tuition will be locked in for up to four years for first-time college students and for up to two years for transfer students.
- Tuition is locked up to four years for first-time college students and for up to two years for transfer students.
